ANOTHER COALITION FAILURE

The Government's offer to the railwaymen has been turned down by a conference of the men's delegates, which extended over three days, and the proposals have been sent back to the Government.

AWAITING THE GOVERNMENT'S REPLY

The Delegates' Conference separated soon after Mr. Thomas had announced its rejection of the Government proposals, and will resume its consideration this morning.

Declaring that there would be no interviews or negotiations with the Government, Mr. Thomas said, rather warmly, "I am going home myself now."
