The object of these Scholarships is to cultivate intelligence, thrift, and resourcefulness on the part of those holding them, and to render them more practical in the performance of home duties of all kinds. The Scholarships will be of the value of £15 each, and will be tenable during the academic year ending July 31st, 1921, at Residential Schools of Domestic Training, by Girls who ARE OVER SIXTEEN AND UNDER TWENTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE on the 1st of SEPTEMBER, 1920, and whose parents or guardians have been resident in the area administered by the Technical Instruction Committee for at least one year immediately preceding the 1st June, 1920.
