

REIGN OF TERROR. ATROCITIES AND OUTRAGES ALL OVER THE COUNTRY. INOFFENSIVE MEN BAYONETED

Shocking Details of Many Cruelties.

This week appears to have regularly inaugurated the Reign of Terror of which we had previously some striking instances from Tuam, Limerick, Thurles, Queenstown, Galway and many other places. Throughout National Ireland, from Dublin to Galway, the papers disclose outrages on the community for which no defence can be advanced. The most grave and terrible of these took place in the little fishing village of BALBRIGGAN.

outside Dublin. There two men were killed, others wounded, a factory destroyed, shops and houses burned. This lawlessness found its provocation seemingly in the shooting of a policeman named Burke, promoted to District Inspector, and his brother who was wounded on the same occasion. Probably the people of the prosperous little town had no association whatever with that shooting, yet they were victimised in a manner which recalled the days of the Hessians and the North Goths in Ireland.

A newspaper representative writes—Revolting details of the killing of Mr. Lynch and Mr. Gibbons, two inoffensive men, by a gentleman who arrived in Dublin. It was first reported that these men had been shot, but it now transpires that they were dragged from their beds by the Black-and-Tans and bayoneted to death in the street by the drink-maddened savages.

Their bodies were stabbed again and again as they lay on the ground. When they were shot, it was reported that they were lying on their faces, but it now appears that they were lying on their backs. The Black-and-Tans were seen to be laughing and shouting as they bayoneted the men. The bodies were then thrown into a ditch and covered with earth.

When word reached Gormanstown, where the Black-and-Tans had a base, a head-constable had been killed in Balbriggan, a large body of the men set out in motor lorries for the scene, and arrived in the town about 11.30 p.m. The men descended from the vehicles, which were lined up in the barracks in Bridge street, and forthwith proceeded systematically through the streets, firing indiscriminately, breaking windows and burning certain selected houses.

Derham's publichouse was first looted, and then burned to the ground. The occupants fled to the back door, at the first arrival of the incendiaries. Inflamed with looted liquor the new Hessians, the dealers in the streets, including Reynolds' grocery establishment and Costello's, dealt out their bullets.

FIRE WITHOUT WARNING. A row of ten thatched cottages in the same street was next attacked and fired. No warning was given to the occupants. They fled in alarm through back doors, and spent the night in the fields. The invaders next appeared in Dublin at the South and North Circular roads, where two large private residences, the licensed premises of Mr. McGowan and Mr. Landy were also looted and burned.

THE MURDER OF THE CIVILIANS. Mystery attaches to the shooting of Mr. James Lawless and Mr. Gibbons, nor is it known at the moment at what stage of the proceedings they were killed. Mr. Lawless, a barber, was a middle-aged man living in Bridge street. His house was completely wrecked, and the looting and burning of his house was a marked episode in the proceedings.

THE BURNING OF THE HOSIERY FACTORY. Messrs Deed and Tempel's hosiery factory, which was burned down, employed some hands, including many women. As the townspeople were afraid to go out of doors, they were unable to describe the method of procedure adopted by the wreckers. All night long up to 3 a.m., they heard the yells and drunken songs of the savages in uniform pumished with incandescent searchlights.
